### **The question for this quarter:**

**Question:** Should Christians purchase a life insurance policy and should they have a will written in the event of their death?

These are two very good questions. In the 70's there was a teaching that Christians should not have life insurance policies. The reason was that having a life insurance policy was not demonstrating faith in God to take care of their funeral expenses upon death—and it also showed a lack of faith, which is sin — *HOW UNTRUE!*

Now that's fine for the deceased; but what about the living family members who do not have the money to pay for an enormous funeral bill? The average funeral expenses, with a one-day viewing is around \$10,000. So, you see funeral expenses are costly and the average family can't afford this type of a burden, due to poor planning.

A few months ago I was ministering to a family who lost a loved one due to violence. The deceased had no life insurance policy and the family didn't know what to do.

This individual's parents were deceased and his siblings and the children of the deceased didn't have the money to pay for the funeral. So they had to set up a burial fund, asking strangers for money to bury their loved one. How sad!

No where in the Bible does it state we are not to have life insurance. God instructs us to be "wise stewards" taking care of our fami-

ly and loved ones financially. This is being a wise steward! Proverbs 27:23 tells us, "*Be thou diligent to know the state of thy flocks, and look well to thy herds.*" In other words, we are to know the state of our financial affairs at all times and be prepared for the unexpected as well as the expected. Far too many individuals are not preparing for their loved ones financial future by not having an insurance policy for themselves and their children. Life insurance policies are not that expensive—it's more costly not to have one!

Trusting God to clean up our poor planning and failure to not plan is tempting God. The purpose of a life insurance policy is to protect the family income in the event of the death of the breadwinner.

Writing a Will is called estate planning. When an individual fails to have a Will or Revocable Trust for their loved ones, the government will do the distribution of the individual's assets. Which causes unnecessary arguing and fighting among family members.

A Will is to be used to instruct the distribution of your personal assets that you want to leave as a "gift" to certain people or organizations. A Revocable Trust Agreement should be used in distribution of liquid assets (money, stock, bonds, 401K, etc.). If these documents are prepared correctly, the heirs of the estate will have to pay very little taxes on their inheritance. You should, though, consult a lawyer for doing both of these documents. In any event everyone should have a Will, a Trust and a Living Will and Life Insurance Policies for self and family.

## *Looking for Love!*

**F**ighting for approval and love can leave one hurt and disappointed time and time again. And, that is what happened to Leah, she was fighting for acceptance and love from her husband Jacob. Leah was the oldest daughter of Laban and sister to Rachel, and as we just read she was married to Jacob.

The Bible tells us, in Genesis 29:16-32, that Rachel was beautiful to look upon and well favored, and Leah was tender eyed. Jacob fell in love with Rachel and requested her in marriage, saying to Laban, her father, he would work for him seven years to marry Rachel.

On the wedding night, Laban tricked Jacob and had Leah wear a wedding veil to cover her face, and sent her into Jacob pretending she was Rachel. The next morning when Jacob discovered the trickery, he was horrified. He had to work another seven years for Rachel. The Bible tells us that Leah was hated (v. 31).

From what we read in scripture Leah and Rachel had constant tension and disagreements over who would have Jacob's attention. And, as you probably guessed, Rachel was the beloved and received Jacob's acceptance and love.

Can you imagine being in a relationship without love and never having the validation of acceptance? Are you looking for someone to love you? Well that was Leah's life. Void of love and acceptance!

In Verses 31 & 32 we read *"And when the LORD saw that Leah was hated, he opened her womb: but Rachel was barren. <sup>32</sup>And Leah conceived, and bare a son, and she called his name Reuben: for she said, Surely the LORD hath looked upon my affliction; now therefore my husband will love me."* God looked upon Leah's affliction and blessed Leah with a family - four sons eventually. But, Rachel remained childless. God saw how unloved and unaccepted she was, so He comforted her.

Leah accepts God's love as a positive force in her life and so can we. God is there to help and heal the brokenhearted and downcast. If you are looking for love and acceptance, stop looking for man's approval and acceptance, receive the unconditional love God has to offer. He tells us in Psalm 27:10 *"when my mother and father forsake me, then the Lord will take me up."* Through God's constant and eternal love we can find the strength to survive our lowest moments.

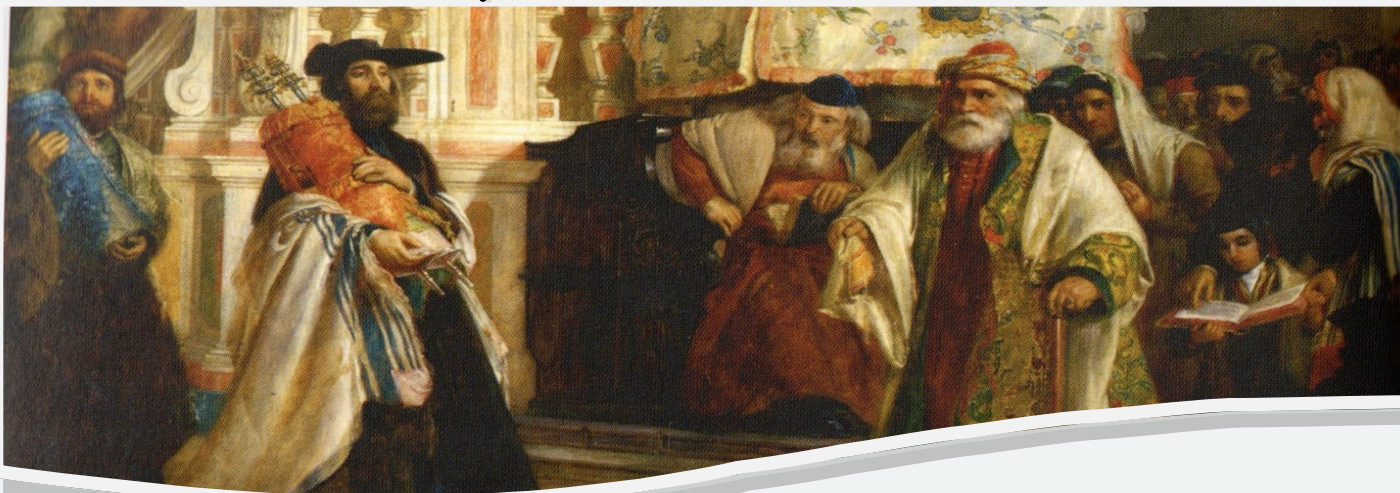

# Old Testament Survey - The Promised Land

The Books of Joshua and Judges will be our topic this quarter. After the death of Moses, God appointed Joshua as leader of His people. The Book of Joshua, covers about 35 years, and tells the reader in detail the battles and victories the children of Israel had while claiming the Promised Land.

We can learn great lessons from the Book of Joshua and Judges as we read God fulfilling His promises and protection to the children of Israel. Joshua was given the assignment of destroying the Canaanite's power because they had turned themselves completely over to perverted religious practices. These perverted practices were "*works of the flesh*." God gave specific instructions to Joshua on how He wanted them to proceed in conquering and destroying the "*works of the flesh*." And, as they destroyed the enemies of God they were to take possession of the land and live on the conquered land.

To receive the Promised Land, the conquest took place in three stages: their belief in God, their faith in God and their obedience to God. The enemies of God weren't going to give up the conquest of their land so easily. So, as the Children of Israel, led by Joshua, followed these three stages of belief, trust, and obedience, God they won their victories.

In the Book of Judges God doesn't appoint a leader for the Children of Israel after the death of Joshua, because He wanted His people to know Him as their supreme ruler: **for example**, the people to live under His law with priests being taught to administer His

law. Unfortunately, the Israelites didn't follow God with their whole heart because they were not successful in destroying the "*works of the flesh*." So, they began the following cycle of: 1) serving the Lord; 2) sinning by going into idolatry; 3) becoming slaves; 4) crying out to God; 5) God raised up a Judge for Israel; 6) and Israel being delivered. This cycle was repeated for a span of 332 years.

God's children of today are no different. We are inconsistent in our walk with God because we are reluctant to destroy the *works of our flesh*. God delivered us from sin and death through salvation by way of the Cross, but we too repeatedly fall short and drift into doubt and unbelief! Why? Because we don't fully understand the victory Jesus won for us on the Cross!

Because of these victories, we don't have to be a slave to sin, emotional wounds, or bad habits. God promises us an abundant life with freedom while living on this earth. Ephesians 1:3-4 says we are blessed in all heavenly places in Christ and John 8:36 says we are free. Free from sin and curses! These are promises from God for every believer. We must trust, believe, and be obedient to God by surrendering our *works of the flesh*. When we daily surrender our works of the flesh, we will walk in victory every day! As children of God we are "blessed" and we need to think and act as children of the Most High God.

What has God promised you! Believe in that promise and receive it today! *Quit walking in defeat!*

The last word in the Bible is Amen (Revelation 22:21).

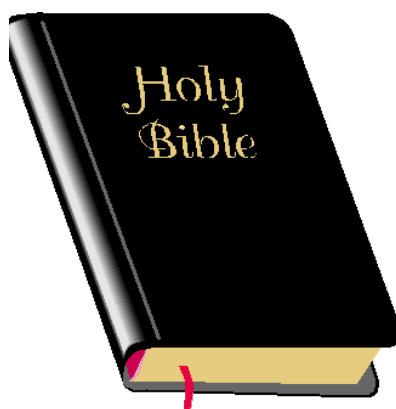
There were four Marys at the cross during the Crucifixion (Mark 15:40 & John 19:25).

**W**hat comes to mind when you think of the Cross? Easter of course!

The Cross and what it represents, *the "finished work of Jesus"* - His death, resurrection, and ascension. The Cross should not only be remembered at Easter, but should be remembered daily. Why? Because of the power found only in the shed *Blood* of Jesus.

One *drop* of the precious Blood of Jesus has more power than all of the 100's of thousands animal sacrifices performed during Biblical times. Animal sacrifices were done to make an atonement for man's sin, but could never take them away, nor redeem mankind back to God (Hebrews 10:11).

You see mankind needed a Savior! A sinless sacrifice that could take away the sins of mankind and redeem them back to God (Hebrews 10:12). So God made Him (Jesus) who knew no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God (2 Cor. 5:21). Jesus suffered a death on the Cross and shed His precious Blood so that we could receive the treasures and power of the Cross. He then took His precious Blood to Heaven and poured it over the Mercy Seat for atonement and cleansing for anyone who trust in Him by becoming a "born again" Christian.

*One of the greatest treasures* of the Cross is Jesus' **love for mankind**. His Love for us is what compelled Him to take the wrath of God that was justly due to mankind.

**Treasure 2:** On the Cross Jesus exchanged His sinlessness for our sins—He who knew no sin became sin for us so that we may have the **forgiveness of sins** (Ephesians 1:7).

**Treasure 3:** Because of what Jesus did on the Cross for mankind, we can receive the **free gift of eternal life** by becoming "born again." The power of the shed Blood of Jesus Christ cleanses us from sin and unrighteousness—making us "children of God" (Ephesians 1:5).

**Treasure 4:** All of **our infirmities** were nailed to the Cross—all our pain, drug habits; sexual sins, anger, sickness, rejection, unhappiness, heartaches, etc. Jesus won the victory for us on the Cross.

**Treasure 5:** His precious Blood has the power to **break every chain** that has anyone bound: drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, bad habits, sexual sins, etc.

The precious Blood of Jesus has the power to heal us and to cleanse us from any situation or problem that we encounter.

What are you going through today? The Blood of Jesus can deliver you from any problem. Struggling with a bad habit? Surrender that habit to God by accepting what Jesus already won for you on the Cross—**VICTORY!** Your answer for deliverance is believing by FAITH and in the power of the shed Blood of Jesus Christ—what He did on the Cross for you!

So remember, no matter what you are struggling with today, the answer is found in Jesus Christ. Freedom is yours, the power of His Blood gives you access to the throne of God. Go to Father God with your troubles believing what Jesus already won for you on the Cross! It is not God's desire for His children to live in prison—you have been set free! Surrender that prison mentality to God!

Due to limited space, only five treasures of the Cross are listed here, there are many more treasures for God's children who dare to trust and believe in *the finished work of the Cross*—*"power in the Blood of Jesus."* Too many Believers are living defeated lives and they don't have to! The "shed blood" of Jesus gives us the power we need. One *drop* of Jesus' blood has the power to cleanse us and to set us free from any bondage and allows us to walk in victory and peace.

During times of discouragement we should look at what David did in Psalm 42:10-11. When men failed him by speaking negative and critical words to him, he became discouraged. David exhibited so much discouragement that he had to draw all his strength from Father God.

In the midst of David's discouragement, he didn't quit, but rather kept his praise on his lips. He praised his way through his discouragement by speaking to his spirit and pressing through into victory.

Yes, he felt depressed but he didn't stop. Psalm 42:10-11 says: "as with a sword in my bones, mine enemies reproach me; while they say daily unto me, where is thy God? Why are thou cast down O my soul? And why art thou disquieted within me? Hope thou in God: For I shall yet praise Him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God."

David arose above their reproach by speaking to his discouragement and depression. His praise to Father God became his strength.

The men in attendance at the meeting were very encouraged by this message of hope, that we can all relate to one time or another.

# The Answer is Always in His Word

## **"OVERCOMING WORDS OF DISCOURAGEMENT" — REV. CHARLES HEAD**

How often have you been told that you aren't good enough? You're too short, your hair is too thin, you're really different, your voice is too soft, etc. It's sad that many of our friends, teachers and sometimes parents say words that can bring discouragement or hurt to us. If we allow them they can even go to the extent of hindering us from our future goals and cause us to suffer rejection, low self-esteem and inferiority complex.

Personally, I can remember negative things that were spoken to me as a child that carried over into my adult life. Many years I struggled with rejection and inferiority complex, but I've learned to lean more on the unconditional love of my Heavenly Father to carry me continuously and lift me up above many negative thoughts. We need to understand the source of negative thoughts. According to God's Word, James 3:5-8 tells us *"Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth! <sup>6</sup> And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell. <sup>7</sup> For every kind of beasts, and of birds, and of serpents, and of things in the sea, is tamed, and hath been tamed of mankind: <sup>8</sup> But the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison."* Since God has provided us with the solution for words of discouragement, we must take our burdens of discouragement to Him first, then as He lifts the burdens, continue to read and apply God's Word to help you become an overcomer.

People will always continue to speak words of discouragement to us, but we must recognize it as a part of the negative world in which we live. Many of us still suffer from negative words spoken to us from childhood and have not dealt with it, but have rather suppressed it. We don't have to live by what some one has spoken over us, God has given us power to reject them and move on, even when it hurts. It doesn't matter what man thinks of us, but it does matter what God thinks of us! The next time a person criticizes you for who you are, you can reject the thought of their words, remember what David said to His Heavenly Father: *"I am fearfully and wonderfully made"* (Psalm 139:14).

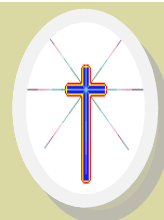
