### WHY THE BIBLE — GEORGETTA HEAD

The question is often asked, "Why should I read the Bible?" or "Is the Bible really true?" Now, before I answer these questions, let me ask – "do you know who you are and why you were created, or why you make the same mistakes over and over?" Do you know the character and ways of God? Do you know the love of God – not "head" knowledge but "heart" knowledge?

The Bible is much more than what some say "is good literary reading" or it makes for a "good fictional book." The Bible was written by man inspired by God for us as our "instruction manual" for living and it's also our roadmap to eternal life. So let me ask you, "after purchasing an item that comes with instructions, do you not read the instructions before assembling the item?" Yes, because you want to know how to assemble it and how the product works.

The same holds true with us humans. We spend our entire life trying to understand who we are and why we do what we do – in other words, what makes us tick. An instruction manual for humans was written thousands of years ago – the Bible. The Bible is full of life skill applications in the area of integrity, living responsibly, loving our fellowman, how to raise our children, how to be a faithful spouse, how to win victory over addictions, working in the workplace, living peacefully with our neighbors etc. You want to learn how

to live righteously and holy – read the manual. As Christians we don't have to live a defeated life full of condemnation and confusion. The Bible is our instruction manual teaching us why we sin, why we are in need of a Savior, and how to live a victorious life every day. Daily reading, studying and proclaiming the Word strengthens you with hope and reassurance. While studying the Word of God you will soon discover numerous promises of blessing that God wants to give to His children as they learn to walk in obedience.



As you read and study the Word, make it a habit to memorize scripture, because at times you will have to quote them as an affirmation for whatever adversity that comes your way (*Thy word I have hid in mine heart,*

*that I might not sin against thee. Psalm 119:11*). In other words what you speak from your mouth you will be declaring and establishing in your life. You speak negative words, you will reap negative actions. You speak positive words (or scripture) you reap positive actions. This truth is also found in Job 22:28 "*You will also declare a thing, and it will be established for you; so light will shine on your ways.*" God is affirming to us that our words have life so be careful what you speak or declare over your life and your family's life.

## FINANCIAL FITNESS—STEPS TO FINANCIAL FREEDOM

Are you still frustrated because you're living day-to-day or paycheck to paycheck? Annoyed with constant hourly calls from creditors? Then it's time for you to surrender your will to God and allow Him to teach you how to be free from worry and anxiety of too much credit card debt or the need to impulse shop.

If you are trapped in the credit card debt, how do you break the cycle? How do you get out of debt when you are in over your head? Let's explore some steps you can take to break the "power of debt" in your life.

First, you need to stop trying to be self-sufficient. God's Word tells us that *"apart from Him, we can do nothing."* Ask God for help in your financial decision making. Make a firm decision today to break the power of debt in your life and ask God to give you the strength, wisdom, and discipline to become debt-free.

Second, stop purchasing items on credit. Crises or the unexpected will happen espe-

cially in the area of finances, but as God's children we don't want to pick up Satan's camouflage of credit cards which will just mask the problem, instead we want to go to God in prayer for a solution for those unexpected expenses. God sees and knows what's happening. He's just waiting for you to pick up the weapon of warfare of prayer and trust in Him. God doesn't operate in the "buy now pay later" mentality. God operates in the power of faith. When you make your crisis bigger than God you will never prosper in your finances.

Thirdly, start a debt-reduction plan. This means using a budget and writing goals. *God's Word tells us that "a prudent man foresees the difficulties ahead and prepares for them; the simpleton goes blindly on and suffers the consequences (Proverbs 22:3 TLB).*

Set a short-term date to be debt free and be determined to see it through. Do a financial inventory of the debt you owe. Prioritize your bills from

the smallest to the largest. This step is very important. Once you determined which bill is the smallest, make this bill the priority to pay off first. If you have to do an inventory of the material possessions in your home to raise money to help pay off this small debt, do it.

Once that small bill is paid off, use the surplus of that money to pay off bill number 2, when that bill is paid, use surplus from bill number 2 to pay off bill number 3, continue in this manner until all credit cards are paid off. (Note, make sure you are making payments on other bills while during this process.)

Fourthly, it's time to start saving money for the future. You need to spend less than you make and you will always have a surplus. As one of your goals, try to learn to live on 70% of your income (i.e., 10% tithe, 20% savings, and 70% budgeted expenses). With a 20% savings account you will be able to set aside money for emergencies, to

## FAMILY CORNER—ELDER CHARLES HEAD

What I have observed over a period of time in reference to the family is the wall that is set up between loved ones caused by disagreements along with the spirit of offense. It is a subtle thing among us as family members, so subtle that most of us have not given much thought on the subject. The old saying is "it's the little foxes that destroy the crops."

While reading this article, think of a situation that's going on in your own family right now, something that happened a short time ago, or something that has been going on for a long period of time. A family member offended or did something in your family that caused a separation among them and the pride within each member involved just won't take down whether right or wrong. As a result the family foundation is weakened in your family. This problem touches many emotions within the family: first, it's a growing problem that causes our children, which are a heritage from the Lord, to observe our actions and follow pursuit themselves. It makes them feel justified with a bad attitude toward life it self.

Whatever happened to being a good example to our children or for others

who may be watching our actions and looking to us for their example to follow. Yes, I know that God only is perfect and we are weak human beings who fail in many areas of life. However, He has made provisions according to His Word for us to live peaceably with each other. *Proverbs 16:7 states "when a man's ways please the Lord, He maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him."* If God has provided a way through His Word for us to have peace with our enemies, how much more does He have the answer for the family?

Secondly, it is very disturbing watching the division in the family and the hate it has produced as a result of offenses. The Bible reference to those who hate their brother is found in *1 John 2:11 "but he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness and knoweth not wither he goest, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes."*

Whether we accept or don't accept God's Word as our solution to the family does not matter, because God's Word is absolute, when we follow His instructions we can save ourselves a lot of unnecessary confusion about what's right or wrong.

## WHY THE BIBLE *(CONT'D)*

Life is full of ups and downs, but its so reassuring to know that there are answers to our questions for daily living and becoming victorious with each battle in life. God has not forsaken His children and does not want them to be ignorant of the help available to them through His Word.

Reading and studying the Bible teaches us who our “real” enemy is. It’s not our neighbor, our husband, our children or our friends. The Bible teaches us our enemy is Satan or the devil. He uses our loved ones, friends, employees, and employers against us to keep division and confusion stirred up in our families and our jobs. Do you want to win the battle? Open your Bible! Learn the tactics and strategies of the enemy. The Bible will teach you the enemy’s character and evil ways; and you will learn the tricks he uses to keep your mind bound with doubts and

fears. Satan doesn’t want you to read the Bible because you will discover the truth *and the truth will set you free!* Free to live a guilt free and joy-filled Christian life. Our Heavenly Father has given his children “all” authority to rebuke Satan. The Word says *“resist Satan and he will flee.”* How do you resist Satan – by quoting the Word of God. Memorizing scriptures is your greatest weapon against the enemy.

Reading the Bible is like plugging into the power source. It’s the direct connection to God. The Bible is God’s way of letting mankind know who He is, what He offers and what He wants from us.

The Book of Proverbs gives excellent advice for practical living on what God wants and expects from us.

The Books of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> John gives

detailed instructions on how and why we should love everyone. The Bible is full of love stories from God to His children calling and admonishing them to be obedient and how not to be tricked by Satan.

Reading and studying the Bible will reveal to us the “great” love God has for us; He wants to have a relationship with everyone of His children. You see my friend, we aren’t deserving of eternal life, but because of God’s wonderful mercy and compassion and love for you and me, His Son Jesus laid down His life for us. In reading the fourth chapter of Ecclesiastes you will notice that the last part of verse 12 states that “a threefold cord is not quickly broken.” So we need to join together as a family unit and stop trying to abide alone. We have one enemy and he is called Satan, God’s Word says he is a liar from the beginning. Friends, let love become our daily motivation for action toward our loved ones.

purchase items on your goal list and to start an investment fund.

If you are in over your head you want to start applying godly principles to your life immediately:

**Put God first.** Sow into God's kingdom (local church) your first 10% tithe.

**Pay yourself second.** As you sow into God's kingdom, sow into your future. Start by setting aside 10% and gradually working up to 20% of your income for savings.

**Reduce bills and outgoing expenses.** Eat at home more often. Don't purchase new clothing without planning for it first. Give yourself an allowance and learn to live on the

allocated allowance (when your allowance is gone don't spend from other categories)

**Don't add new debt.** When tempted to spend what you don't have, stop and ask God for strength to walk away. Memorize scriptures and speak them out loud when tempted.

Deuteronomy 8:18 states that *God has given each Christian the power to get wealth so that He might establish his covenant in the earth.* God has placed in each one of us the ability to take control of personal financial situations, to live successful lives, and to make a positive contribution to society. Jesus already paid the price for our prosperity, spiritually and otherwise *"He became poor, so that you*

*through his poverty might become rich"* (2 Corinthians 8:9). God wants us to get our financial houses in order, He wants us to learn to be good stewards over the money and resources He entrusted to us.

So contrary to what some think, living debt-free is not difficult, it's about living a disciplined life using godly principles and making wise financial choices.

Remember, God owns it all. Learn to spend less than you make. Start your plan (budget) today. Pay your 10% tithe and pay yourself 10-20% (savings). And, finally, never, never be a surety (cosigner) on a loan for anyone.

Not that I have already obtained it or have already become perfect, but I press on so that I may lay hold of that for which also I was laid hold of by Christ Jesus.

Instruction Manual for Living



Did you know that Sarah was 91 years old when she gave birth to her son Isaac (Gen. 18:9-14)?

## IS HEALING FOR TODAY?

Contrary to what some think, yes, healing is available today for God's children. Sickness is not a blessing, it's a curse, and it is not God's will for His children to be sick with physical illness, emotional illness, mental illness, etc. God's Word tells us that sickness is a curse of the Law (Deut. 28:15, 61). When Jesus Christ died on the Cross, He destroyed the curse of the law, which included sickness and infirmities (Isaiah 53:5; Matthew 8:16-17).

Healing, like salvation is available to all that by "faith" believe. Believe by faith that God's Word accomplishes what He purposes it to do. God's Word is medicine to the soul. The Word of God is life and when we speak His Word over our illness, problems, infirmities, etc. and believe His Word to be Truth, we will receive what we ask of God.

To develop the faith needed to know what God's Word says about healing, we need to seek God in prayer and study His Word. Until we know what God's will is, there is nothing on which to base our faith. It is important to know that our mind must be in harmony with the mind of God. The right mental

attitude, or the "renewed" mind makes a steadfast faith possible to all who believe in divine healing (Romans 12:2). If you continue to talk doubt and unbelief, God's Word won't work for you. *Hearing God's Word and acting on it is "faith."*

The Bible tells us there is no Word of God without power. Psalm 107:20 tells us "He sent His Word, and healed them." All we have to do is firmly believe what the Word says about healing. We need to refuse to believe anything that contradicts the Word. We are to take sides with God and believe that all we need for our spirit, soul, and body is already ours. We need to have the attitude "*if God says it, I believe it.*"

When asking God for healing, do not be double-minded. The Book of James tells us, "*but let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.*"

Does God heal today, yes. Healing is received by acting on faith. "*Believe*

*and you shall receive.*"

### Scriptures:

**Isaiah 53:5** But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed

**Matthew 8:16-17** When evening came, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed; and He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were ill. This was to fulfill what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet: "HE HIMSELF TOOK OUR INFIRMITIES AND CARRIED AWAY OUR DISEASES."

**Romans 12:2** And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

**Ephesians 2:10** For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things He planned for us long ago."

"Jesus said unto him, "I am the way, the truth and the life, no man comes to the Father but by Me." (John 14:16)

\*Are you in need of a Savior today? God loves you and offers a wonderful plan for your Life. All you need to do is pray the "sinner's prayer below!!

\*Dear Jesus, I come to you today as a lost sinner. I am asking that you save my soul and cleanse me from all sin. I know that I need help and that I can't save myself. I believe that you are the Son of God. Forgive me for my sins and all wrong doings I have done to others and help me to forgive those who have hurt me.
